Dear Ms. Thomas:

We are in receipt of your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*

On February 11, 2019, we received your request for a Metra Police report possibly dated between 1995 – 1998 concerning a reported kidnapping and robbery. You supplemented your request with additional information indicating your name at the time of the incident was Meaghan Olson and your mother’s name, which may also be noted in the report, is [REDACTED]. Further, you indicated that this incident was filed at Chicago Union Station (“Request”).

After performing a diligent search of Metra’s records, we have been unable to locate any records responsive to your Request. Metra’s Police Department advises its database contains information which dates back to May 1998; however, no records concerning a kidnapping or robbery, or by searching the names Meagan Olson or [REDACTED] were located.
