Dear Sir or Madam,

I am writing to request a copy of my records stemming from an incident on Jun14,2019. At approximately 10:48 pm, I approached the intersection of Routes22 and Route 43..It was very dark outside without any street lights or light from other cars in the streets. It was also raining heavily. I could barely see in front of my car and there were no safety reflective posts installed to guide traffic. When the light turned green, I followed the right turn arrow painted on the asphalt and it guided me on to the train tracks!! I put my emergency blinkers on when the wheels of my car got stuck in the rocks lining the train tracks. I grabbed my purse and climbed out the gully and climbed up the rocks to the curb.

as I began to call 911 in the rain, Some local good samaritans spotted standing on the curb. Both he Bannockburn and Deerfield police respond and they contacted Metra as I could see the light of an approaching train. I was put in the police car to get me out of the rain and then the tow truck arrived.
