There's also a \$6 Day Pass for shorter rides within one to three zones. For weekend trips, our \$7 Saturday or Sunday Pass is good for unlimited rides on either day. Or choose our \$10 Weekend Pass for unlimited rides on both weekend days.

Buckingham Fountain	One of the largest fountains in the world with dazzling light displays
Chicago Riverwalk	1.25-mile pathway to Lake Michigan
Chicago Water Tower	One of just a few surviving structures still standing from the Great Chicago Fire of 1871
Civic Opera House	The permanent home of the Lyric Opera of Chicago
Garfield Park Conservatory	One of the largest botanical conservatories in the world
Lincoln Park Zoo/Conservatory	A free, family-oriented wildlife experience in the heart of Chicago
Millennium Park	Cloud Gate ("the Bean"), ice skating, art displays, and outdoor events
Navy Pier	An iconic destination on the lakefront and one of the most-visited attractions in the Midwest
Willis Tower	Once the tallest building in the world and still referred to as the "Sears Tower" by locals

Daley Plaza	Hosts seasonal events and festivals, plus features the beloved untitled sculpture by Pablo Picasso
McCormick Place	Convention center and home of the Chicago Sky and DePaul Basketball
Northerly Island/Huntington Bank Pavilion	A 91-acre peninsula that hosts outdoor concerts with sweeping views of the skyline
The Second City	The world's premier comedy club, comedy theater, and school of improvisation

Design Museum of Chicago	Inspires, educates, and fosters innovation through design

Steppenwolf Theatre Company	The nation's premier ensemble theatre located in Lincoln Park

Harold Washington Library	Named in honor of Chicago's first African American mayor, this is the central library for the Chicago Public Library system
Pullman National Monument	The first National Park Service unit in Chicago and home to many historic buildings
Vietnam Veterans Fountain	One of the largest Vietnam memorials outside of Washington D.C.
