Lake Shore Drive (LSD) Bascule Bridge widening and rehabilitation project is nearing completion

Congratulations to the Chicago Department of Transportation as the Lake Shore Drive (LSD) Bascule Bridge widening and rehabilitation project nears completion. Originally completed in 1937, repairs to the architecturally significant structure was paramount to CDOT's project goals. Widening the sidewalk to 22' was not only a more economical approach compared to building a separate bridge, but also preserves the historic entry to the city over the Chicago River. WSP USA served as the Engineer-of-Record and provided conceptual and concept study, preliminary engineering services and final design (PS&E) as well as construction phase technical consulting.
