

FULL PAGE

Trim Size: 8.5" w x 11" h

Safety Size: 8" w x 10.5" h (.5" in from trim)

Bleed size: 8.75" w x 11.25" h (.125" bleed)

QUARTER PAGE

Trim Size: 4.1875" w x 5.5" h

Safety Size: 3.6875" w x 5" h (.5" in from trim) Bleed Size: 4.4375" w x 5.75" h (.125" bleed)

HALF PAGE

Trim Size: 8.5" w X 5.5" h

Safety Size: 8" w X 5" h (.5" in from trim) Bleed Size: 8.75" w X 5.75" h (.125" bleed)

- All art should be at 300 dpi/ppi at 100% size.
- The following file types are accepted:
 - Adobe Acrobat
 - Save as X-1A or Press Quality format with fonts embedded.
 - Adobe Photoshop
 - JPG, TIFF, or PSD
 - PNG files at 300 ppi are accepted but not recommended.
 - Adobe Illustrator
 - Al or EPS files with fonts outlined and images embedded.
 - Al or EPS file with packaged links and fonts included.
 - Adobe InDesign
 - INDD or IDML files with packaged links and fonts included.
- Not accepted formats: PowerPoint, Word, Publisher, Excel, Freehand, Corel Draw,
 Paint, and Quark.
- All screen and printer fonts must be provided if fonts are not outlined.
- Fonts may be substituted if originals are not provided.
- If proofing errors are discovered, new art may need to be provided when text is outlined.
